The A person receiving WHO RECEIVES an advertisement in violation of this act may file a civil suit in the court of proper jurisdiction to recover actual damages — or $\frac{250.00}{ATTOR}$ [\$1,000.00 \$500.00], whichever is greater, PLUS REASONABLE ATTOR-NEY FEES, if any of the following <u>had</u> occurred <u>prior to</u> BEFORE the person <u>receiving</u> RECEIVED the advertisement: (a) The attorney general <u>had</u> issued a notice to cease and desist under section 3 to the person who sent the advertisement.
