

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled  
"Public health code,"  
by amending sections 16131 and 16263 (MCL 333.16131 and  
333.16263), as amended by 1995 PA 126, and by adding section  
16350 and part 189.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 16131. The terms of office of individual members of  
2 the boards and task forces, except those appointed to fill vacan-  
3 cies, ~~shall~~ expire 4 years after appointment as follows:

15 (2) Notwithstanding section 16261, a person who was spe-  
16 cially trained at an institution of higher education in this  
17 state to assist a physician in the field of orthopedics and upon  
18 completion of training, received a 2-year associate of science  
19 degree as an orthopedic physician's assistant before January 1,  
20 1977, may use the title "orthopedic physician's assistant"  
21 whether or not the person is licensed under this article.

1                   PART 189. NUTRITION AND DIETETICS

2           SEC. 18901. (1) AS USED IN THIS PART, "REGISTERED NUTRI-  
3 TIONIST AND DIETITIAN", EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSEC-  
4 TION (2), MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO INTEGRATES AND APPLIES SCIEN-  
5 TIFIC PRINCIPLES OF FOOD, NUTRITION, BIOCHEMISTRY, PHYSIOLOGY,  
6 MANAGEMENT, AND BEHAVIORAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES TO ACHIEVE AND  
7 MAINTAIN THE HEALTH OF INDIVIDUALS THROUGH THE PROVISION OF  
8 NUTRITION CARE SERVICES, ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, COUNSELING  
9 SERVICES, EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, FOOD SERVICES, FOOD SAFETY SERV-  
10 ICES, INFORMATIONAL SERVICES, NUTRITION THERAPY SERVICES, MANAGE-  
11 MENT SERVICES, AND SAFETY AND SANITATION SERVICES AND WHO IS REG-  
12 ISTERED AS A NUTRITIONIST AND DIETITIAN UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

13           (2) REGISTERED NUTRITIONIST AND DIETITIAN DOES NOT INCLUDE  
14 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

15           (A) FURNISHES INFORMATION ON FOODS, FOOD PRODUCTS, OR  
16 DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE MARKETING OR DISTRIBU-  
17 TION OF THOSE FOODS, FOOD PRODUCTS, OR DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS, AS  
18 LONG AS HE OR SHE DOES NOT HOLD HIMSELF OR HERSELF OUT AS A REG-  
19 ISTERED NUTRITIONIST AND DIETITIAN.

20           (B) PROVIDES WEIGHT CONTROL SERVICES.

21           (3) IN ADDITION TO THE DEFINITIONS IN THIS PART, ARTICLE 1  
22 CONTAINS GENERAL DEFINITIONS AND PRINCIPLES OF CONSTRUCTION  
23 APPLICABLE TO ALL ARTICLES IN THIS CODE, AND PART 161 CONTAINS  
24 DEFINITIONS APPLICABLE TO THIS PART.

25           SEC. 18903. BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDA-  
26 TORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS PART, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT USE THE  
27 TITLES "REGISTERED NUTRITIONIST AND DIETITIAN" OR "R.N.D." OR

1 SIMILAR WORDS THAT INDICATE THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A REGISTERED  
2 NUTRITIONIST AND DIETITIAN UNDER THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS THE INDI-  
3 VIDUAL IS REGISTERED UNDER THIS ARTICLE AS A REGISTERED NUTRI-  
4 TIONIST AND DIETITIAN.

5 SEC. 18905. THE MICHIGAN BOARD OF NUTRITION AND DIETETICS  
6 IS CREATED IN THE DEPARTMENT AND CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 7  
7 VOTING MEMBERS WHO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 161:

8 (A) TWO PUBLIC MEMBERS.

9 (B) FIVE MEMBERS WHO ARE REGISTERED DIETITIANS AND NUTRI-  
10 TIONISTS AND WHO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16135(2), AND  
11 BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

12 (i) POSSESS A BACCALAUREATE OR HIGHER DEGREE FROM A UNITED  
13 STATES REGIONALLY ACCREDITED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION  
14 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT WITH A MAJOR COURSE OF STUDY IN HUMAN  
15 NUTRITION, NUTRITION EDUCATION, FOODS AND NUTRITION, DIETETICS,  
16 OR FOOD SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. AN APPLI-  
17 CANT FOR THE INITIAL BOARD WHO HAS OBTAINED HIS OR HER EDUCATION  
18 OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES OR ITS TERRITORIES SHALL HAVE HIS OR  
19 HER ACADEMIC DEGREE VALIDATED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS EQUIVALENT TO  
20 A BACCALAUREATE OR HIGHER DEGREE CONFERRED BY A UNITED STATES  
21 REGIONALLY ACCREDITED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION APPROVED BY  
22 THE DEPARTMENT.

23 (ii) HAVE NOT LESS THAN 900 HOURS OF SUPERVISED POSTCOLLEGE  
24 OR PLANNED CONTINUOUS AND VERIFIABLE PREPROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE  
25 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

26 SEC. 18907. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A REGISTRATION TO AN  
27 INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT,

1 PAYS THE APPLICABLE FEES UNDER SECTION 16350, AND MEETS ALL OF  
2 THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

3 (A) POSSESSES A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE FROM A UNITED STATES  
4 REGIONALLY ACCREDITED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION APPROVED BY  
5 THE DEPARTMENT WITH A MAJOR COURSE OF STUDY IN HUMAN NUTRITION,  
6 NUTRITION EDUCATION, FOODS AND NUTRITION, DIETETICS, OR FOOD SYS-  
7 TEMS MANAGEMENT, OR AN EQUIVALENT COURSE OF STUDY, AS APPROVED BY  
8 THE DEPARTMENT.

9 (B) HAS NOT LESS THAN 900 HOURS OF SUPERVISED POSTCOLLEGE OR  
10 PLANNED CONTINUOUS PREPROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE AS PRESCRIBED IN  
11 RULES PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

12 (C) PASSES AN EXAMINATION THAT IS APPROVED BY THE  
13 DEPARTMENT.

14 SEC. 18909. A REGISTRATION ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER  
15 SECTION 18907 IS RENEWABLE UPON PAYMENT OF THE PRESCRIBED REGIS-  
16 TRATION RENEWAL FEE. NOTWITHSTANDING THE REQUIREMENTS OF  
17 PART 161 AND BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND RENEWAL PERIOD AFTER THE  
18 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS PART, THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE A REGISTRANT  
19 SEEKING RENEWAL OF A REGISTRATION TO FURNISH THE BOARD WITH EVI-  
20 DENCE THAT DURING THE 1 YEAR BEFORE AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL  
21 THE REGISTRANT HAS ATTENDED CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES OR PRO-  
22 GRAMS APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND TOTALING NOT LESS THAN 12  
23 CLOCK-HOURS IN SUBJECTS RELATED TO NUTRITION AND DIETETICS THAT  
24 ARE DESIGNED TO FURTHER EDUCATE REGISTRANTS.

25 SEC. 18911. THIS PART DOES NOT REQUIRE NEW OR ADDITIONAL  
26 THIRD-PARTY REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY AN INDIVIDUAL  
27 REGISTERED UNDER THIS PART.
