SEC. 2922A. (1) A PERSON WHO COMMITS A WRONGFUL OR NEGLI GENT ACT AGAINST A PREGNANT INDIVIDUAL IS LIABLE FOR DAMAGES IF
 THE ACT RESULTS IN A MISCARRIAGE OR STILLBIRTH BY THAT INDIVIDUAL
 OR PHYSICAL INJURY TO THE EMBRYO OR FETUS.

6 (A) AN ACT COMMITTED BY THE PREGNANT INDIVIDUAL.
