## TITLE

An act to provide limits on the rate of taxation on property; —, and to provide for a division of the rate of taxation between counties, townships, municipal corporations, intermediate school districts, and other local units; —and— to earmark funds raised by increasing the total tax limitation; TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES AND PROVIDE REMEDIES; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts and charters and parts of charters of municipal

9 corporations inconsistent with or contravening the provisions of 10 this act.

Sec. 5a. (1) A vote on adopting separate tax limitations shall be initiated by petition signed by not less than 4% of the registered electors of each township and city within the county. The petition shall be filed with the county clerk not less than and be fore the convening of the board in regular session, or any special session called for the purpose of considering the petition.
