# SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5346

A bill to amend 1917 PA 273, entitled

"An act to regulate and license pawnbrokers in cities and incorporated villages of this state, having a population of more than 3,000," by amending sections 5, 9, 10, 11, and 14 (MCL 446.205, 446.209, 446.210, 446.211, and 446.214); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5. (1) Every such A pawnbroker shall keep a book to be inspected by the chief of police or chief police officer of the city or village RECORD in which shall be IS written in English, at the time he shall receive THE PAWNBROKER RECEIVES any article of personal property —, or other valuable thing by way of pledge or pawn, a description of such THE article, A SEQUENTIAL TRANSACTION NUMBER, the ANY amount of money loaned thereon, the rate of interest to be paid on such loan, the

1 name, residence, and general description, AND DRIVER LICENSE 2 NUMBER, OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD NUMBER, OR 3 GOVERNMENT IDENTIFICATION NUMBER of the person from whom THE 4 ARTICLE WAS RECEIVED, and the day and hour when such property 5 THE ARTICLE was received. -; and such book, and THE RECORD, the 6 place where such THE business is carried on, and all articles 7 of property therein, shall be IN THAT PLACE OF BUSINESS ARE 8 subject to examination at any time by the mayor, president, 9 city attorney, or other police officer of such city or village 10 or by LOCAL POLICE AGENCY, the COUNTY prosecuting attorney or 11 the sheriff or other police officer of the county in which 12 -said THE city or village is situated, OR THE DEPARTMENT OF 13 STATE POLICE.

(2) UPON THE RECEIPT OF ANY ARTICLE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR
OTHER VALUABLE THING BY WAY OF PAWN, THE PAWNBROKER SHALL MAKE A
PERMANENT RECORD OF THE TRANSACTION ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE
PAWNBROKER THAT SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLIES WITH THE FORM DESCRIBED IN
SUBSECTION (4). EACH RECORD OF TRANSACTION SHALL BE COMPLETED IN
DUPLICATE BY THE PAWNBROKER, LEGIBLY IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE, AND
SHALL CONTAIN ALL APPLICABLE INFORMATION REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE
RECORD OF TRANSACTION FORM UNDER SUBSECTION (4). THIS SUBSECTION
DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE USE AND TRANSMISSION OF THE INFORMATION
REQUIRED IN THE RECORD OF THE TRANSACTION BY MEANS OF COMPUTER OR
OTHER ELECTRONIC MEDIA AS PERMITTED BY THE LOCAL POLICE AGENCY
WITHIN THE APPLICABLE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT.

(3) THE PAWNBROKER SHALL RETAIN A RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION
 AND, WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER THE PROPERTY IS RECEIVED, SHALL SEND 1

3 (2) A pawnbroker may also charge <u>50 cents</u> \$1.00 per month
4 or fraction <u>thereof</u> OF A MONTH for the storage of property <u>-</u>,
5 except jewelry, after 30 days but for not more than 4 months,
6 under any single pledge or pawn. <u>No</u>

7 (3) A pawnbroker or THE PAWNBROKER'S agent or employee
8 thereof shall make a loan upon any deposit, pawn or pledge at a
9 rate of interest and SHALL NOT charge or receive therefor
10 INTEREST ON THE LOAN in excess of the amounts provided for in
11 this act.

12 (4) Interest on any loan <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> payable in 13 advance <u>—</u> and shall be computed on unpaid monthly balances 14 <u>only</u>, but without compounding.

15 (5) A pawnbroker is not entitled to any examination fee or
16 to AND SHALL NOT make any charge in excess of the amounts pro17 vided for in this act.

18 Sec. 10. (1) TITLE TO THE ITEM PLEDGED OR PAWNED VESTS IN 19 THE PAWNBROKER UPON THE EXPIRATION OF 3 MONTHS OR OF ANY PERIOD 20 BEYOND 3 MONTHS AGREED UPON BY THE PARTIES IF THE BORROWER HAS 21 NOT PAID THE DEBT, INTEREST, AND CHARGES ON THE ITEM PLEDGED OR 22 PAWNED.

23 (2) No A pawnbroker shall NOT sell any pawn or pledge
24 until the same shall have ITEM HAS remained 6 months in his
25 OR HER possession FOR AT LEAST 3 MONTHS. , and all such sales
26 shall be at public auction to the highest bidder, and not
27 otherwise. Such sale shall be held under the direction and

1 control of the pawnbroker and in his regularly established place 2 of business. Notice of such sale shall be published for at least 3 6 days previous thereto in 1 of the daily newspapers to be desig-4 nated by the mayor or president, published in English, in the 5 city or village where the business is carried on: Provided, That 6 if there be no daily newspaper in such city or village, said 7 notice shall be published at least 2 successive weeks, in a 8 weekly newspaper, to be designated by the mayor or president, 9 published in English, in such city or village. Such notice shall 10 specify the time and place at which such sale is to take place 11 and by whom it is to be conducted, and shall contain the same 12 description of the articles or goods to be sold as was given in 13 the memorandum or note delivered to the pawner under section 8 of 14 this act, and shall give the number of such memorandum or note. 15 An affidavit of the printer of such paper or of his foreman, or 16 his principal clerk, annexed to a printed copy of such notice 17 taken from the paper in which it was published and specifying the 18 times when and papers in which it was published, shall be filed 19 after the last day of such publication and before the day fixed 20 for such sale with the county clerk of the county in which such 21 sale is held. Such affidavit shall be kept in the office of the 22 said county clerk as a public document, and open to the inspec-23 tion of any person. A fee of 50 cents shall be paid by the party 24 filing such affidavit to the county clerk for the filing of the 25 same.

26 Sec. 11. The borrower, IF at any time prior to BEFORE
27 the sale , may pay or tender OF THE ITEM PLEDGED OR PAWNED THE

House Bill No. 5346 7 1 BORROWER PAYS OR TENDERS to the pawnbroker the debt and interest 2 and charges thereon, together with the cost of advertising the 3 sale, if the sale has been advertised. The ON THE ITEM, THAT 4 payment or tender shall reinvest REINVESTS the pawner with the 5 title and right of possession to the property pledged. Sec. 14. No pawnbroker shall receive any pledge, pawn, 6 7 articles or thing whatever from any person after receiving from 8 any 1 of the officers mentioned in section 5 of this act, or the 9 parent or guardian of any minor or person of unsound mind, writ-10 ten notice that such person is a minor, or is of unsound mind, or 11 neglects all lawful business, or that he habitually spends his 12 time in frequenting houses of ill-fame, gambling houses or tippl-13 ing houses, or that from drinking, gaming, idleness or debauchery 14 of any kind he is squandering his earnings or wasting his estate, 15 or that he is likely to bring himself or family to want, or to 16 render himself or family a public charge, or that he is suspected

17 of thievery. No A pawnbroker shall NOT receive any FOR pawn 18 ANY ARTICLE from any person under 18 years of age OR A PERSON THE 19 PAWNBROKER SUSPECTS AS HAVING STOLEN THE ARTICLE TO BE PAWNED.

20 Enacting section 1. Section 12 of 1917 PA 273, MCL 446.212, 21 is repealed.
