A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled "Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan," by amending sections 20c and 24a (MCL 259.20c and 259.24a), as added by 1996 PA 370, and by adding chapter IA and section 20d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER IA
- 2 SEC. 1A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY EXISTING DENIAL, LIMITATION,
- 3 OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, ACCESS TO OR USAGE OF PUBLIC USE
- 4 FACILITIES AND PRIVATE LANDING AREAS WITHIN THIS STATE SHALL NOT
- 5 BE DENIED, LIMITED, OR REGULATED, NOR SHALL FLIGHT OPERATIONS,
- 6 INCLUDING THOSE AT AIRPORTS, BE DENIED, LIMITED, OR REGULATED ON
- 7 THE BASIS OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S RACE, RELIGION, CREED, COLOR,
- 8 NATIONAL ORIGIN, GENDER, ANCESTRY, LINEAGE, DESCENT, HEREDITY, OR
- 9 FAMILIAL RELATIONSHIP.

- 15 OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, THE OWNER AND ANY PERSON AUTHO-
- 16 RIZED BY THE OWNER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO USE SUCH PRIVATE LAND-
- 17 ING AREA. Commercial operations shall not be conducted on private
- 18 landing areas.
