## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5617

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SEC-
