(A) "HOSPITAL" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 20106 1 2 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20106.

(B) "Hospital heliport" means a heliport limited to serving 3 4 helicopters engaged in air ambulance or other hospital related 5 functions.

SEC. 20D. "HOSPITAL HELISTOP" MEANS A MINIMALLY DEVELOPED 6 7 FACILITY FOR THE BOARDING AND DISCHARGING OF HELICOPTER CREW AND 8 PASSENGERS AND THE LOADING AND UNLOADING OF HELICOPTER CARGO 9 SOLELY FOR AN AIR AMBULANCE OR OTHER HOSPITAL-RELATED FUNCTIONS. Sec. 24a. "Private landing area" means any location, either 10 11 on land or water, that is used for the <u>take-off</u> TAKEOFF or 12 landing of aircraft, and is to be used by the owner or persons 13 authorized by the owner. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY EXISTING LIMITATION 14 OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, THE OWNER AND ANY PERSON AUTHO-15 RIZED BY THE OWNER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO USE SUCH PRIVATE LAND-16 ING AREA. Commercial operations shall not be conducted on private 17 landing areas.
