

HOUSE BILL No. 4121

January 28, 1997, Introduced by Rep. Whyman and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9948) by adding section 1903.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1903. (1) A PERSON CONVICTED OF ANY FELONY, MISDEMEAN-
2 OR, OR ORDINANCE VIOLATION SHALL NOT COMMENCE OR MAINTAIN A CIVIL
3 ACTION FOR ANY DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE INCIDENT FROM WHICH
4 THAT CONVICTION AROSE.

5 (2) THE COURT SHALL DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE A CIVIL ACTION
6 COMMENCED OR MAINTAINED IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1).

7 (3) THE PERIOD OF LIMITATIONS FOR BRINGING A CIVIL ACTION
8 PROHIBITED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS TOLLED FOR THE PERIOD THAT AN
9 APPEAL OF THAT CONVICTION IS PENDING IN A COURT OF THIS STATE, OF
10 ANOTHER STATE, OR OF THE UNITED STATES.

1 (4) THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY ONLY TO CONVICTIONS OCCURRING
2 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS
3 SECTION.
