## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 529a. (1) A person who by force or violence, or by
- 2 threat of force or violence, or by putting in INCITING fear
- 3 robs, steals, or takes a motor vehicle as defined in section 412
- 4 from another person, in the presence of that person, or the
- 5 presence of a passenger, or in the presence of any other
- 6 person in lawful possession of the motor vehicle, is guilty of
- 7 carjacking, a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or for
- 8 any term of years.
