the state; to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify laws
relating to the environment and natural resources of the state;
to regulate the discharge of certain substances into the environment; TO DECLARE THE RIGHT TO CERTAIN USES OF RENEWABLE
RESOURCES; to regulate the use of certain lands, waters, and
ther natural resources of the state; to prescribe the powers and
duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to
provide for certain charges, fees, and assessments; to provide
