A bill to amend 1959 PA 96, entitled

"An act to prescribe the conditions under which persons, firms, corporations and municipalities may enter upon, construct and maintain bus passenger shelters upon public highways within the corporate limits of municipalities; to permit the posting of advertisements thereon; and to provide for the regulation thereof,"

by amending the title and section 5 (MCL 247.335) and by adding section 4a.

22 Sec. 5. The construction, MANAGEMENT, and maintenance of 23 all such bus passenger shelters shall be deemed to be UNDER 24 THIS ACT IS for the use and convenience of the public. , but 25 nothing in this section or in sections 2, 3 or 4 shall be con-26 strued to THIS ACT DOES NOT grant any rights whatsoever to 27 any A person, firm, corporation, or municipality whatsoever or
