THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 1165. BEGINNING IN THE 1998-99 SCHOOL YEAR, IF
REQUESTED BY 1 OR MORE PARENTS OF PUPILS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT, A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PROVIDE A GUN SAFETY COURSE FOR
ITS PUPILS OR RESIDENTS. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT ITSELF MAY OFFER
THE GUN SAFETY COURSE OR MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE INTERMEDIATE
SCHOOL DISTRICT OR ANOTHER ENTITY TO PROVIDE THE COURSE. THE
SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, MAY CHARGE A
FEE FOR THE GUN SAFETY COURSE. THE FEE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE
ACTUAL COSTS OF PROVIDING THE GUN SAFETY COURSE.
