A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled
"General sales tax act,"
(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4h.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 4H. A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE
2 FROM THE GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX SALES
3 OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT USED IN THE DISPENSING OF ANY FORM OF MEDI-
4 CATION FOR DIABETES, INCLUDING SYRINGES, OR USED IN THE TESTING
5 OF BLOOD FOR THE CONTROL AND TREATMENT OF DIABETES.
