- 9 CENTER COMPLEX THAT HOUSES THE LIBRARY OF MICHIGAN SHALL BE
- 10 DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE WILLIAM FAUST MEMORIAL LIBRARY OF
- 11 MICHIGAN.
