1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Optional retirement program" means a system of retire3 ment benefits established as a part of the plan of compensation
4 for eligible teaching and administrative personnel.

5 (b) "Retirement system" means the Michigan public school
6 employees' retirement system created by the public school employ7 ees retirement act of 1979, Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
8 1980, being sections 38.1301 to 38.1408 of the Michigan Compiled
9 Laws 1980 PA 300, MCL 38.1301 TO 38.1408.

10 (c) "Eligible employees" means the members of the faculty 11 and administrative staff of state supported institutions of

1 higher education on a full-time basis whose positions require the 2 performance of professional services in the discharge of the edu-3 cational or administrative functions of the institution. FOR A 4 STATE SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT IS A COMMU-5 NITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION (D)(viii) OR 6 (ix), "ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES" MEANS ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMUNITY 7 OR JUNIOR COLLEGE.

8 (d) "State supported institution of higher education" means9 any of the following:

10 (*i*) Western Michigan university.

11 (*ii*) Eastern Michigan university.

12 (*iii*) Northern Michigan university.

13 (*iv*) Central Michigan university.

14 (v) Michigan technological university.

15 (vi) Ferris state university.

16 (vii) Lake Superior state university.

17 (viii) A community or junior college established pursuant to18 section 7 of article VIII of the state constitution of 1963.

19 (*ix*) A community or junior college established pursuant to 20 part 25 of the REVISED school code, of 1976, Act No. 451 of the 21 Public Acts of 1976, being sections 380.1601 to 380.1607 of the 22 Michigan Compiled Laws 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1601 TO 380.1607. 23 (e) "Board of control" means the board charged with policy 24 direction of a state supported institution of higher education.
