

HOUSE BILL No. 6090

September 16, 1998, Introduced by Rep. Callahan and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 642, entitled
"Revised probate code,"
(MCL 700.1 to 700.993) by adding section 402.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 402. (1) BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1999, THE STATE COURT
2 ADMINISTRATOR SHALL ESTABLISH A SYSTEM OF COLLECTING ACCURATE
3 DATA ON ADULT GUARDIANSHIPS AND CONSERVATORSHIPS. THE SYSTEM
4 SHALL BE DESIGNED TO YIELD AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR
5 EACH COUNTY FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR:

6 (A) THE NUMBER OF PETITIONS FILED TO ESTABLISH A
7 GUARDIANSHIP.

8 (B) THE NUMBER OF PETITIONS FILED TO ESTABLISH A
9 CONSERVATORSHIP.

1 (C) EXCLUDING SUCCESSOR GUARDIANS, THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS
2 FOR WHOM A GUARDIAN OR CONSERVATOR WAS APPOINTED SEPARATED INTO
3 THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

4 (i) A FULL GUARDIAN AND A CONSERVATOR.

5 (ii) A FULL GUARDIAN, BUT NO CONSERVATOR.

6 (iii) A LIMITED GUARDIAN AND A CONSERVATOR.

7 (iv) A LIMITED GUARDIAN, BUT NO CONSERVATOR.

8 (v) A CONSERVATOR, BUT NO GUARDIAN.

9 (D) COUNTING COFIDUCIARIES ONCE, THE NUMBER OF GUARDIANS
10 APPOINTED SEPARATED INTO THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

11 (i) RELATIVE.

12 (ii) FRIEND.

13 (iii) INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER.

14 (iv) COUNTY GUARDIAN OR COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR.

15 (v) CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, OR INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL.

16 (E) COUNTING COFIDUCIARIES ONCE, THE NUMBER OF CONSERVATORS

17 APPOINTED SEPARATED INTO THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

18 (i) RELATIVE.

19 (ii) FRIEND.

20 (iii) INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER.

21 (iv) COUNTY GUARDIAN OR COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR.

22 (v) A STATE OR FEDERALLY CHARTERED BANK.

23 (vi) CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, OR INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL.

24 (F) ON DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS
25 WHO HAVE A GUARDIAN OR A CONSERVATOR, REGARDLESS OF THE YEAR

26 APPOINTED, SEPARATED INTO THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

- 1 (i) A FULL GUARDIAN AND A CONSERVATOR.
2 (ii) A FULL GUARDIAN, BUT NO CONSERVATOR.
3 (iii) A LIMITED GUARDIAN AND A CONSERVATOR.
4 (iv) A LIMITED GUARDIAN, BUT NO CONSERVATOR.
5 (v) A CONSERVATOR, BUT NO GUARDIAN.
6 (2) THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR SHALL MAKE THE INFORMATION
7 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC AND SHALL PROVIDE THE INFORMATION TO THE
8 HOUSE AND SENATE STANDING COMMITTEES AND APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOM-
9 MITTEES WITH LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT OVER GUARDIANSHIP AND CONSER-
10 VATORSHIP ISSUES OR JUDICIAL BRANCH ISSUES.
