# **ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 1218**

AN ACT to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled "An act to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify the laws relating to mental health; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials and certain private agencies and individuals; to regulate certain agencies and facilities providing mental health services; to provide for certain charges and fees; to establish civil admission procedures for individuals with mental illness or developmental disability; to establish guardianship procedures for individuals with developmental disability; to establish procedures regarding individuals with mental illness or developmental disability who are in the criminal justice system; to provide for penalties and remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts," by amending section 1001b (MCL 330.2001b), as amended by 1995 PA 290.

*The People of the State of Michigan enact:*

- Sec. 1001b. (1) "Place of detention" means a detention facility operated by a political subdivision of the state.
- (2) "Prisoner" means a person confined in a state correctional facility, but does not include any of the following:
- (a) A person confined pursuant to an order of a juvenile division of the probate court or the family division of circuit court.
  - (b) A person confined in a place of detention.
  - (c) A person who is on parole from a state correctional facility.
- (3) "Protective environment" means an environment that supports mental health services in accordance with a prisoner's individual plan of services.
- (4) "State correctional facility" means a facility that houses prisoners and is operated by the department of corrections, and also includes a youth correctional facility operated by the department of corrections or a private vendor under section 20g of 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.220g.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
