- ${\bf 3}$  [DEPENDENT MINOR] TO RIDE, IN THE OPEN BED OF A PICKUP TRUCK ON A HIGHWAY IN
- 4 A CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP.
- 5 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO THE OWNER, OPERATOR, OR
- 6 A PASSENGER OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATED AS PART OF A PARADE PURSUANT TO
- 8 A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT WITH JURISDICTION OVER
- 9 THE HIGHWAY OR STREET.
- 10 (B) A MILITARY MOTOR VEHICLE.
