# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 72a. (1) The township board shall provide by resolu tion for the time and place of its regular meetings, and shall
 hold not less than 1 regular meeting every 3 months. If a time
 set for the holding of a regular meeting of the township board
 is a holiday, as designated by the township board, the regular
 meeting shall be held at the same time and place on the next sec ular day that is not a holiday.

8 (2) A special meeting of the township board shall be held at
9 a time fixed by the board at a meeting or when the supervisor
10 considers it necessary. Upon call of the supervisor, the

(6) (5) The \$50,000,000.00 amount provided for in subsec-6 7 tion -(4) (5) shall be adjusted as of January 1 of each year, 8 beginning January 1, 1998. The department of treasury shall 9 determine on or before December 1 of each year, beginning **10** December 1, 1997, an adjusted amount for the following year. The 11 adjusted amount for each year shall be determined by comparing 12 the consumer price index for the 12-month period ending the pre-13 ceding October 31 with the corresponding consumer price index of 14 1 year earlier. The percentage increase or decrease shall then 15 be multiplied by the current adjusted amount. The product shall 16 be rounded up to the nearest multiple of \$1,000,000.00 and shall 17 be the new adjusted amount. The department of treasury shall 18 provide the adjusted amount upon request. As used in this sec-19 tion, "consumer price index" means the annual average percentage 20 increase in the Detroit consumer price index for all items as 21 reported by the United States department of labor.
