A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding sections 81140a and 82147a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 81140A. (1) IF THE OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
- 2 OF A PERSON WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE IS SUSPENDED OR
- 3 REVOKED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE
- 4 CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923, OR IF THE DRIVER LICENSE
- 5 OF A PERSON WHO IS A NONRESIDENT IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED UNDER
- 6 THE LAW OF THE STATE IN WHICH HE OR SHE RESIDES, THAT PERSON
- 7 SHALL NOT OPERATE AN ORV UNDER THIS PART FOR THE SAME PERIOD.
- 8 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-
- 9 MEANOR PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:
- 10 (A) FOR A FIRST CONVICTION, IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN
