 SIXTH GRADE, shall present to school officials, at the time of
 registration or not later than the first day of school, a certif icate of immunization or statement of exemption under section
 9215.

9 (2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter
10 or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum
11 of 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases
