## HOUSE BILL NO. 5962

(As passed the House, November 30, 2000)

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 1301 (MCL 600.1301).

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1301. (1) In counties having a population of less than 2 2,000,000, the jury board shall consist CONSISTS of 3 qualified 3 electors of the county appointed by the <u>governor</u> COUNTY BOARD 4 OF COMMISSIONERS on recommendation of the circuit judges of the 5 judicial circuit in which the county is situated, not more than 2 6 of whom shall be members of the same political party. The <u>first</u> 7 appointment of members of the jury board shall be for terms of 2, 8 4 and 6 years. Thereafter appointments shall be for 6-year 9 terms.
10 (2) In counties having a population of 2,000,000 or more,

The board of supervisors 21 may prescribe the procedure for the orderly transition of
