A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 5431 (MCL 333.5431), as amended by 1998 PA 88.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5431. (1) A health professional in charge of the care
 of a newborn infant or, if none, the health professional in
 charge at the birth of an infant shall administer or cause to be
 administered to the infant a test for each of the following:

- 5 (a) Phenylketonuria.
- **6** (b) Galactosemia.
- 7 (c) Hypothyroidism.
- 8 (d) Maple syrup urine disease.
- 9 (e) Biotinidase deficiency.
