CHAPTER VI

- Sec. 4. (1) Within 15 days after the passage of an ordinance IS PASSED, the CLERK SHALL PUBLISH THE ordinance or a synopsis of the ordinance shall be published in a newspaper circulated in the village. Immediately after publication THE ORDINANCE OR SYNOPSIS OF THE ORDINANCE IS PUBLISHED, the clerk shall
 enter in the record of ordinances, in a blank space to be left
 for that purpose under the record of the ordinance, a SIGNED
