

SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 906

A bill to amend 1974 PA 300, entitled
"Motor vehicle service and repair act,"
by amending section 10 (MCL 257.1310).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 10. (1) A person may become certified as a specialty
2 mechanic if that person has passed an examination, ~~which~~
3 DEVELOPED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR OR DEVELOPED BY A PRIVATE ENTITY
4 AND ADOPTED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR, THAT the administrator deter-
5 mines is an adequate test of a person's ability to perform cer-
6 tain types of motor vehicle repair. The repair categories for
7 which certification is required include the following and others
8 that may be specified by rule:
9 (a) Engine repair.
10 (b) Automatic transmission.

1 (c) Manual transmission and rear axle.

2 (d) Front end.

3 (e) Brakes.

4 (f) Electrical systems.

5 (g) Heating and air conditioning.

6 (h) Engine tune-up.

7 (I) PRE-1973 MOTOR VEHICLE, SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3).

8 (2) A person may apply for a specialty mechanic's certifi-
9 cate in any or all repair categories but shall be required to pay
10 only 1 certification fee if the person makes the applications for
11 more than 1 category at ~~one~~ 1 time.

12 (3) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDA-
13 TORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL
14 DEVELOP OR ADOPT AN EXAMINATION FOR SPECIALTY MECHANIC CERTIFICA-
15 TION IN THE REPAIR CATEGORY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(I) FOR AN
16 INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED, FOR COMPENSATION, IN THE REPAIR OF A MOTOR
17 VEHICLE MANUFACTURED BEFORE 1973 OR THE RECONDITIONING, REPLACE-
18 MENT, ADJUSTMENT, OR ALTERATION OF THE OPERATING CONDITION OF ANY
19 COMPONENT OR SUBASSEMBLY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE MANUFACTURED BEFORE
20 1973.

21 (4) ~~(2)~~ A person may apply for and receive a master
22 mechanic's certificate if that person is qualified as a specialty
23 mechanic in all categories of motor vehicle repair EXCEPT THAT
24 THE SPECIALTY CATEGORY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(I) IS NOT NEC-
25 ESSARY FOR A MASTER MECHANIC'S CERTIFICATE.
