by amending section 728 (MCL 339.728), as added by 1997 PA 10.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 (1) A firm organized for the practice of public Sec. 728. 2 accounting shall apply for and obtain a license under this arti-3 cle in order to engage in the practice of public accounting in 4 this state. The firm applying for licensure under this article 5 shall meet both of the following requirements:

(a) At least -2/3 A SIMPLE MAJORITY of the equity and 6 7 voting rights of the firm are held directly or beneficially by 8 individuals who are licensed in good standing as certified public 9 accountants of this or another state or the equivalent in another 10 licensing jurisdiction acceptable to the board.

(b) The principal officer of the firm and each officer or
director having authority for the practice of public accounting
by the firm are licensed in good standing as certified public
accountants in this or another state or the equivalent in another
licensing jurisdiction acceptable to the board.
