THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 357b. (1) A person who commits larceny by stealing the
 firearm of another person is guilty of a felony — punishable by
 imprisonment for not LESS THAN 5 YEARS OR more than -5- 15 years
 or by a fine of not more than \$2,500.00, or both.

5 (2) A PERSON WHO POSSESSES A FIREARM KNOWING OR HAVING
6 REASON TO KNOW THE FIREARM WAS STOLEN IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION
7 (1) IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS
8 THAN 5 YEARS OR MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
9 \$2,500.00, OR BOTH.
