A bill to establish the office of Michigan minority ombudsman; to prescribe its powers and duties; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and departments.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Minority" means an individual who is African-American,
3 Asian-American, Eskimo, Hispanic, or American Indian.

4 (b) "Minority-owned business" means a business that is at5 least 50% owned, controlled, and managed by minorities.

6 Sec. 2. The office of the Michigan minority ombudsman is
7 created within the department of civil rights. The principal
8 executive officer of the office is the Michigan minority ombuds9 man, who shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and
10 consent of the senate.

Sec. 3. (1) The office of the Michigan minority ombudsman
 is responsible for assisting minority-owned businesses in using
 services of the state available to those businesses.

4 (2) The department of civil rights, the department of con5 sumer and industry services, the Michigan jobs commission, the
6 department of management and budget, and the department of trea7 sury shall assist the office of Michigan minority ombudsman in
8 executing the duties described in subsection (1).
