

HOUSE BILL No. 4650

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled
"General sales tax act,"
(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 10.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 10. BEGINNING IN 2000, FEBRUARY 20 OF EACH YEAR IS
2 DESIGNATED AS THE SALES TAX-FREE MICHIGAN HOLIDAY. A PERSON
3 SUBJECT TO THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE FROM THE GROSS PRO-
4 CEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX ALL SALES OF TANGIBLE
5 PERSONAL PROPERTY TRANSACTED ON FEBRUARY 20 OF EACH YEAR.
