



HOUSE BILL No. 5714

May 2, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Schauer, Basham, Jamnick, Gielegem, Dennis, Martinez, Hale, Pappageorge and Jacobs and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 520n.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 520N. IF A PERSON CHARGED WITH VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING
2 TO VIOLATE SECTION 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G AGREES TO A
3 PLEA BARGAIN UNDER WHICH THE ORIGINAL CHARGE IS DISMISSED AND A
4 PLEA OF GUILTY IS ENTERED TO ANY MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE PUNISHABLE
5 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR 92 DAYS OR LESS OR A FINE OF \$1,000.00 OR
6 LESS, OR BOTH, THE PERSON SHALL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE HIS OR HER
7 FINGERPRINTS TAKEN AND FORWARDED AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3(5) OF
8 1925 PA 289, MCL 28.243.
