## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER IX
- 2 SEC. 15. NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 3 THIS SECTION, AND AT LEAST ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE STATE COURT
- 4 ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE TO EACH TRIAL COURT THAT HAS
- 5 JURISDICTION OVER CRIMINAL PROSECUTIONS INVOLVING POSSESSION OR
- 6 DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES INFORMATION ON THE DENIAL
- 7 OF FEDERAL BENEFITS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 421 OF PART D OF THE
- 8 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT, TITLE II OF THE COMPREHENSIVE DRUG
- 9 ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT OF 1970, PUBLIC LAW 91-513, 21
- 10 U.S.C. 862, AND ON THE TRIAL COURT'S AUTHORITY UNDER THAT SECTION
- 11 TO DENY FEDERAL BENEFITS IN SENTENCING FOR A STATE OFFENSE.
