## SENATE BILL NO. 317

February 17, 1999, Introduced by Senator BENNETT and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 74103a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 74103A. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE YEAR-ROUND
- 2 CAMPING OPPORTUNITIES AT STATE PARKS. THE DEPARTMENT MAY DETER-
- 3 MINE HOW MANY AND WHICH STATE PARKS TO KEEP OPEN TO SATISFY THE
- 4 DEMAND FOR NON-SUMMER-SEASON CAMPING SITES ACROSS THE STATE.
- 5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW CAMPERS TO STORE EQUIPMENT AT
- 6 CAMPING SITES DURING FALL, WINTER, AND SPRING CAMPING SEASONS
- 7 DURING PERIODS OF TIME IN WHICH THE CAMPING SITES WILL NOT OTHER-
- 8 WISE BE USED. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE INDIVIDUALS PARTICI-
- 9 PATING IN THE STORAGE PROGRAM TO SIGN A LIABILITY WAIVER
- 10 RELEASING THE STATE FROM ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SECURITY OF
- 11 STORED EQUIPMENT FROM LOSS, DAMAGE, OR THEFT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY

- 1 ESTABLISH REASONABLE CONDITIONS FOR THE STORAGE OF EQUIPMENT AT
- 2 CAMPING SITES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 ANNUALLY ESTABLISH FEES FOR EQUIPMENT STORAGE AT STATE PARKS FOR
- 4 SUNDAY THROUGH THURSDAY NIGHTS, OTHER THAN HOLIDAYS. THESE FEES
- 5 SHALL BE BASED UPON THE ADDITIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH RUNNING
- 6 THE EQUIPMENT STORAGE PROGRAM. EQUIPMENT STORAGE FEES FOR
- 7 FRIDAYS, SATURDAYS, AND HOLIDAYS SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE OVER-
- 8 NIGHT CAMPING FEE FOR THE SITE.
