A bill to amend 1971 PA 227, entitled

"An act to prescribe the rights and duties of parties to home solicitation sales,"

(MCL 445.111 to 445.117) by adding section 13.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 13. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE FOR
 THE OPERATION OF A REGISTER ON WHICH TO COMPILE A LIST OF TELE PHONE NUMBERS OF RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBERS WHO OBJECT TO
 RECEIVING TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS. THE REGISTER MAY BE OPERATED
 BY THE COMMISSION OR BY ANOTHER ENTITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE
 COMMISSION. THE FOLLOWING ARE THE GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATION
 OF THE REGISTER:

8 (A) RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBERS MAY ENROLL ON THE REG-9 ISTER AS PROVIDED BY THE COMMISSION. ENROLLMENT ONTO THE

1 REGISTER WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE 30 DAYS FOLLOWING THE DATE OF 2 ENROLLMENT BY THE SUBSCRIBER.

3 (B) A RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBER WILL REMAIN IN THE DO
4 NOT CALL REGISTER UNTIL THE SUBSCRIBER REQUESTS THAT THE COMMIS5 SION REMOVE HIS OR HER NAME FROM THE REGISTER.

6 (C) BUSINESS TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBERS MAY NOT BE INCLUDED ON7 THE REGISTER.

8 (D) THE COMMISSION WILL UPDATE THE REGISTER AT THE BEGINNING9 OF EACH MONTH.

10 (E) THE COMMISSION MAY PURGE THE REGISTER PERIODICALLY IN11 ORDER TO ENSURE ACCURACY.

12 (2) THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE DATABASE IS NOT OPEN TO
13 PUBLIC INSPECTION OR DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
14 ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246. THE COMMISSION WILL TAKE
15 ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO PROTECT THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE INFOR16 MATION IN THE DATABASE.

17 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL FORWARD THE LIST OF MICHIGAN SUB18 SCRIBERS ON THE REGISTER TO THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS
19 COMMISSION'S OR ANY OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES' DO NOT CALL NATIONAL
20 DATABASE, IF AND WHEN A FEDERAL LIST IS ESTABLISHED.

21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take22 effect unless Senate Bill No. 990

23 of the 90th Legislature is enacted into24 law.
