

SENATE BILL No. 1016

February 16, 2000, Introduced by Senator GAST and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of state police and certain other state purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the various state agencies.
