The bills amend two sections of the Michigan Liquor Control Code by clarifying that a licensee can not be charged with a violation involving selling or furnishing alcohol to a minor unless enforcement action is also taken against the person who sold or furnished the liquor to the minor, even when that person is the licensee's clerk, agent, or employee. They would have no fiscal impact on the State or on local units of government.
