Currently, schools must provide 180 days of instruction each school year. However, districts are allowed to exempt up to two days from this requirement for days in which school must be cancelled due to conditions beyond the school's control, such as snow and ice. HB 4297 would add school closures due to orders by lawful authorities to the list of reasons for which a district may exempt a day from the required number of instruction days. The bill keeps the maximum number of days which may be expempted at two days and has no state or local fiscal impact.
