6 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

7 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

8 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state consti-
9 tution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal year
10 2001-2002 is \$7,421,000.00. State payments to local units of government
11 under this act are \$7,421,000.00.

12 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures authorized
13 under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards,
14 offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act
15 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to
16 18.1594.

17 **DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERVICES**

18 Sec. 301. The appropriation in part 1 for fire protection grants
19 from the liquor purchase revolving fund shall be appropriated to cities,
20 villages, and townships with state-owned facilities for fire services,
21 instead of taxes, in accordance with 1977 PA 289, MCL 141.951 to
22 141.956.
