HOUSE BILL NO. 5506

(As passed the House, February 7, 2002)

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 204a (MCL 750.204a), as amended by 1998 PA 208.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 204a. (1) A person who, with the intent to terrorize,
- 2 frighten, intimidate, threaten, harass, or annoy any other
- 3 person, POSSESSES, delivers, sends, transports, or places a
- 4 device that is constructed to represent an explosive, incendiary
- 5 device, or bomb, or that is presented as an explosive, incendiary
- 6 device, or bomb, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment
- 7 for not more than 5 years or a fine of not more than \$3,000.00,
- 8 or both.
- 9 (2) An offense is committed under this section if the device
- 10 is delivered or sent from this state or is POSSESSED,
