## HOUSE BILL NO. 5661

(As passed the House, March 7, 2002) (As amended by the Senate, May 9, 2002)

A bill to amend 1897 PA 153, entitled

"An act to provide for the payment of expenses in matters in which the state is a party or interested,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 14.111); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. That in all cases where IN ALL CASES IN WHICH the 2state is a party or interested, in which the attorney general 3participates, whenever it becomes necessary to subpoena witnesses 4—, or to defray other necessary expenses of <u>such</u> THAT litiga-5tion, the attorney general is hereby authorized to <u>present a</u> 6voucher for PAY the amount that he <u>deems</u> OR SHE CONSIDERS nec-7essary , to the auditor general, and the auditor general shall 8thereupon draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for said 9amount, and the state treasurer shall pay the same OUT OF FUNDS
