HOUSE BILL NO. 5661

(As passed the House, March 7, 2002)

(As amended by the Senate, May 9, 2002)

A bill to amend 1897 PA 153, entitled

"An act to provide for the payment of expenses in matters in  
which the state is a party or interested,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 14.111); and to repeal acts and parts  
of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. ~~That in all cases where~~ IN ALL CASES IN WHICH the  
2state is a party or interested, in which the attorney general  
3participates, whenever it becomes necessary to subpoena witnesses  
4~~, or to defray other necessary expenses of such~~ THAT litiga-  
5tion, the attorney general is hereby authorized to ~~present a~~  
6~~voucher for~~ PAY the amount that he ~~deems~~ OR SHE CONSIDERS nec-  
7essary ~~, to the auditor general, and the auditor general shall~~  
8~~thereupon draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for said~~  
9~~amount, and the state treasurer shall pay the same~~ OUT OF FUNDS
