THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 503. Punishment of felonies when not fixed by
- 2 statute--A IF A person IS convicted of a crime declared in this
- 3 or any other act of the state of Michigan, to be a felony -,
- 4 for which no other punishment is specially prescribed, by any
- 5 statute in force at the time of the conviction and sentence,
- 6 shall be punished THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE by
- 7 imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 4 years or
- 8 by a fine of not more than $\frac{2,000 \text{ dollars}}{2,000 \text{ dollars}}$ \$5,000.00, or by
- 9 both. such fine and imprisonment.
