## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2922a. (1) A person who commits a wrongful or negli-
- 2 gent act against a pregnant individual is liable for damages if
- 3 the act results in a miscarriage or stillbirth by that
- 4 individual, or physical injury to OR THE DEATH OF the embryo or
- 5 fetus.
- 6 (2) This section does not apply to any of the following:
- 7 (a) An act committed by the pregnant individual.
- **8** (b) A medical procedure performed by a physician or other
- 9 licensed medical HEALTH professional within the scope of his or
- 10 her practice and with the pregnant individual's consent or the
