Sec. 4. On and after May 1, 1998, a A person —, who for compensation manufactures or assembles public playground equipment —, that fails to comply with the following standards is subject to a state civil infraction under this act:

8 to the commission by the COMSIS corporation in March 1990 in
9 "development of human factors criteria for playground equipment
