SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 720

A bill to amend 1968 PA 319, entitled

"An act to provide a uniform crime reporting system; to provide for the submitting of such report to the department of state police; to require submission of the report by certain police agencies; to require the reporting on wanted persons and stolen vehicles; to require the reporting of information regarding certain persons and unidentified bodies of deceased persons; to prescribe certain powers and duties of law enforcement agencies; and to vest the director of the department of state police with certain authority,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.257).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. The chief of police of each city or village, the
- 2 chief of police of each township having a police department, and
- 3 the sheriff of each county within this state shall report to the
- 4 department of state police, in a manner prescribed by the depart-
- 5 ment, the following information related to crimes of domestic
- 6 assault VIOLENCE INCIDENTS:

- 18 (e) Other statistics the director of the department of state
- 19 police considers necessary to obtain accurate and reliable data
- 20 on the incidence of domestic assault VIOLENCE in this state.
