

# HOUSE BILL No. 6284

September 17, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Ruth Johnson, Birkholz, Palmer, Voorhees, Vander Veen, Richardville, Ehardt, Cameron Brown, Meyer, Shulman, Cassis, Van Woerkom, Rocca, Caul, Pappageorge, DeRossett and Kooiman and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for the department of environmental quality for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.
