THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Construction mechanic" means a skilled or unskilled
- 3 mechanic, laborer, worker, helper, assistant, or apprentice work-
- 4 ing on a state project but shall DOES not include executive,
- 5 administrative, professional, office, or custodial employees.
- 6 (b) "State project" means new construction, alteration,
- 7 repair, installation, painting, decorating, completion, demoli-
- 8 tion, conditioning, reconditioning, or improvement of public
- 9 buildings, schools, works, bridges, highways, or roads
- 10 authorized by a contracting agent.

- (c) "Contracting agent" means any officer, school board,
- 2 board or commission of the state, or a state institution sup-
- 3 ported in whole or in part by state funds, authorized to enter
- 4 into a contract for a state project or to perform a state project

- 8 (d) "Commissioner" means the department of labor CONSUMER
