A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled

by amending section 16z of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16z), as amended
by 2000 PA 279.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 16z. This chapter applies to the following felonies
enumerated in chapter 750 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
