A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 5653 (MCL 333.5653), as amended by 2000 PA 58.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5653. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Health facility" means a health facility or agency
- 3 licensed under article 17.
- 4 (b) "Hospice" means that term as defined in section 20106.
- 5 (c) "Medical treatment" means a treatment including, but not
- 6 limited to, palliative care treatment, or a procedure, medica-
- 7 tion, surgery, a diagnostic test, or a hospice plan of care that
- 8 may be ordered, provided, or withheld or withdrawn by a health
- 9 professional or a health facility under generally accepted
- 10 standards of medical practice and that is not prohibited by law.

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- (d) "Patient" means an individual who is under the care of a
 physician.
- 3 (e) "Patient advocate" means that term as described and used
- 4 in sections 5506 to 5512 of the estates and protected individuals
- 5 code, 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.5506 to 700.5512.
- 6 (f) "Patient surrogate" means the parent or legal guardian
- 7 of a patient who is a minor, or a member of the immediate family,
- 8 the next of kin, or the legal guardian of a patient who has a
- 9 condition other than minority that prevents the patient from
- 10 giving consent to medical treatment.
- 11 (g) "Physician" means that term as defined in section 17001
- **12** or 17501.
- 13 (h) "Terminal illness" means a disease or condition due to
- 14 which, in the opinion of a physician, a patient's death is
- 15 anticipated within 6 months after the date of the physician's
- 16 opinion PATIENT HAS A REDUCED LIFE EXPECTANCY.
- 17 (2) Article 1 contains general definitions and principles of
- 18 construction applicable to all articles in this code.
