## **SENATE BILL No. 1028**

## January 30, 2002, Introduced by Senator MC COTTER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 503 and 504 (MCL 750.503 and 750.504).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 503. Punishment of felonies when not fixed by
 statute--A- IF A person IS convicted of <u>a crime declared in this</u>
 or any other act of the state of Michigan, to be a felony —,
 for which no <u>other</u> punishment is specially prescribed, <u>by any</u>
 statute in force at the time of the conviction and sentence,
 shall be punished THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE by
 imprisonment <u>in the state prison</u> for not more than 4 years or
 by a fine of not more than <u>2,000 dollars</u> \$5,000.00, or <u>by</u>
 both. <u>such fine and imprisonment</u>.
